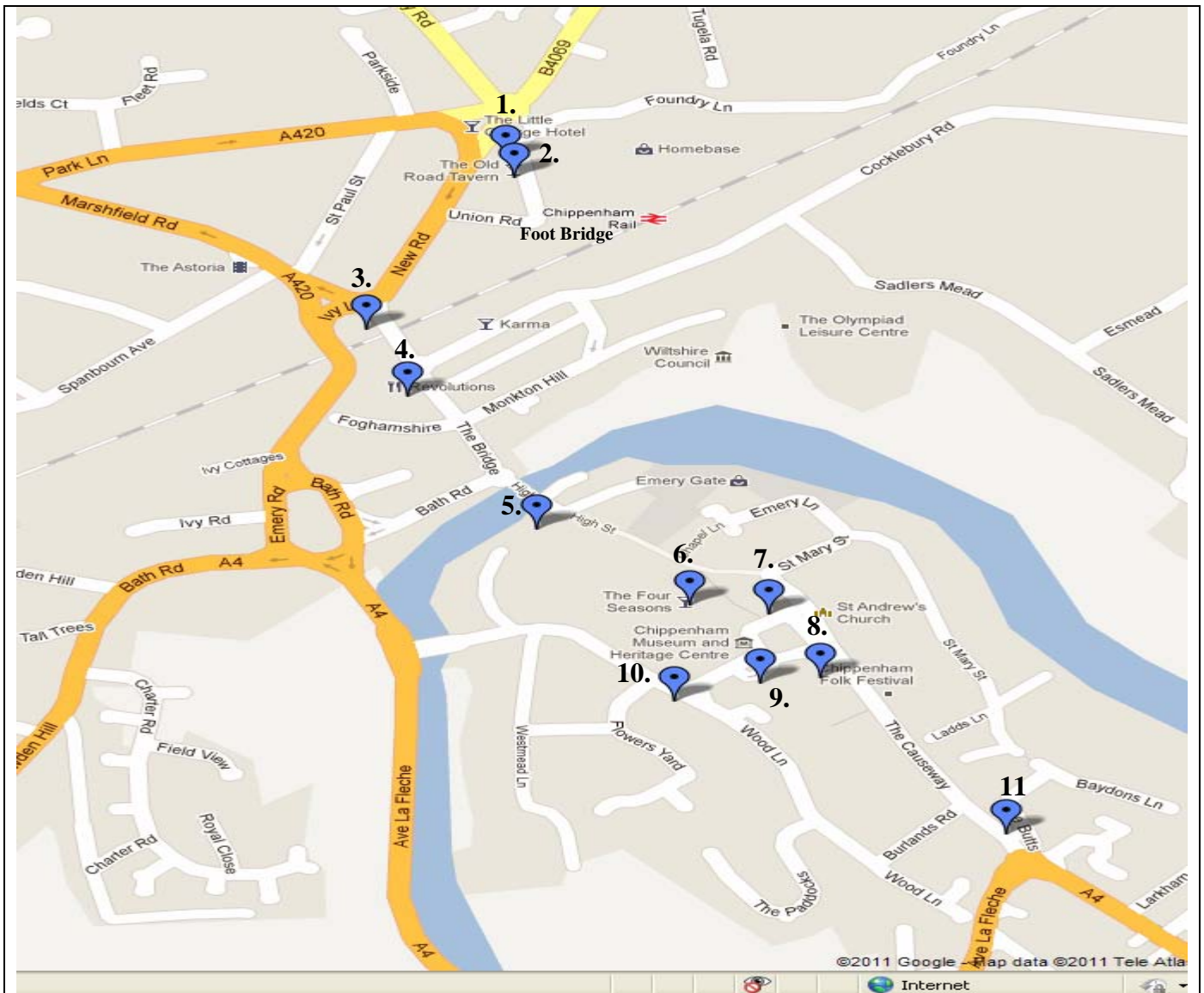


# Chippenham - Real ale pubs
