### Buy a Wiltshire Day Rover and travel right through!

Wiltshire Day Rover tickets allow you unlimited travel on the buses of the participating companies as listed. The system is simple. You board your first bus and pay the driver, who will give you a ticket and a Wiltshire Day Rover wallet.

Seal the ticket inside the wallet. When you receive your Day Rover ticket, check that the date and price are correct.

**Remember the Wiltshire Day Rover ticket** is **only** valid on the services of the bus companies listed overleaf.

Senior citizens not eligible for free transport in Wiltshire could include visitors from Scotland, Wales and abroad. Also some senior citizens may wish to purchase a Wiltshire Day Rover ticket if travelling out of Wiltshire or need to start their journey early, as fares can be higher before 0900 with some bus operators.

**Avebury** Stone Circle, West Kennet Long Barrow, Alexander Keiller Museum, The Great Barn and other sites. Served by service 49 from Devizes and Trowbridge; 5/6 from Swindon; 95/96 and 'Connect2 Wiltshire' from Marlborough and Calne.

**Bath** Roman Baths, Pump Room, Abbey, Holburne Museum, Royal Crescent, The Circus, Shops, Theatres, Cinemas, Postal and Costume Museums, and The American Museum. Served by service 264/265 from Warminster, Westbury, Trowbridge and Bradford-on-Avon; service 228 from Colerne; services 231/232, X31 from Chippenham and Corsham; 271/272/273 from Devizes and Melksham plus other occasional services.

**Bradford on Avon** Saxon Church 14th C. Bridge, Tythe Barn, Kennet and Avon Canal, delightful walks in historic Town and by River Avon. Served by 264/265 from Bath, Trowbridge, Westbury and Warminster.

**Castle Combe** Picturesque Cotswold village with museum. Served by service 35 from Chippenham.

**Cirencester** Historic Cotswold Town, Corinium Museum, Roman Remains. Served by service 51 from Swindon; 93 from Malmesbury.

**Corsham** Corsham Court and Underground Quarry Centre. Served by services 231/232, X31 from Bath and Chippenham; 72/73 from Melksham.

**Devizes** Devizes is the centre of the Wiltshire Bus Network. It is a pleasant Market Town with access to the Kennet and Avon Canal and it's famous Caen Hill Locks. Regular services link the town to Salisbury – service 2; Swindon, Avebury and Trowbridge – service 49; Melksham and Bath – services 271/272/273; Calne and Chippenham – service 33/X33; Westbury – service 87.

**Kennet and Avon** Canal runs from Reading to Bristol attracting thousands of visitors a year. Service 264/265 Warminster to Bath route, stops at Bradford on Avon. Service 271/272/273 Bath to Melksham to Devizes.

Service 49 Trowbridge to Devizes to Avebury to Swindon. The 'Connect2 Wiltshire' serves some points.

**Lacock** Rustic photogenic village with Abbey and the Fox Talbot Museum. Much used as a film location. Served by services 234, X34 from Chippenham, Trowbridge and Melksham; 73 from Corsham.

**Malmesbury** Oldest Borough in England, Market town, Abbey. Served by services 41 from Yate; 31 from Swindon; 93 from Cirencester; 92 from Chippenham.

**Marlborough** Fine Georgian Market Town, Merchants House Museum, Old Coaching Inns and Tea Rooms. Served by services 48,70,95/96 from Swindon; 95/96 and 'Connect2 Wiltshire' from Avebury; 20/22 from Hungerford; 95/96 from Salisbury; 80 from Ludgershall and Tidworth; 'Connect2 Wiltshire' from Calne.

**Salisbury** Cathedral, Mompesson House, Local Museums, Wilton House, Old Sarum. Served by services 2 from Devizes; 24 from Warminster; 8 from Ludgershall and Tidworth; 29 from Shaftesbury; 34, 36 from Romsey; X7 from Southampton.

**Stourhead** National Trust house and gardens. Served by the 'Connect2 Wiltshire' Mere area service from Gillingham, Mere, Warminster and Hindon – please ring 01380 860100 for more details.

**Swindon City** Centre Shops, Outlet Village, Theatres and Cinemas. Served by services 31 from Malmesbury; 46 from Hungerford; 47 from Lambourn; 48,70,95/96 from Marlborough; 80 from Andover, Ludgershall and Tidworth; 49 from Devizes and Trowbridge; 51 from Cirencester; 55 from Chippenham and Calne; 66 from Oxford; plus local services.

**Trowbridge** County Town with Museum and thriving shopping centre. Served by services 49 from Swindon and Devizes; 234, X34 from Frome and Chippenham; 234, 237, X34 from Melksham; 264/265 from Bath, Bradford, Warminster and Westbury.
